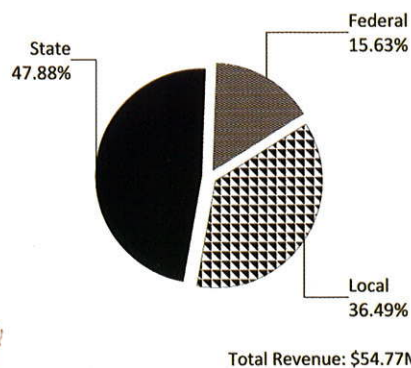

#### Revenue Sources



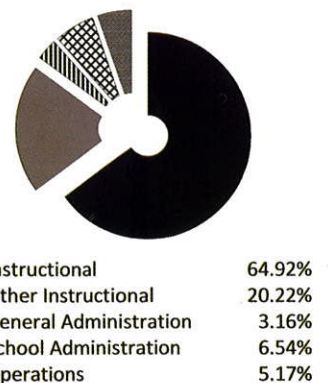
