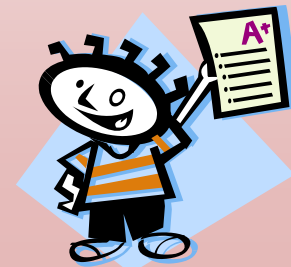
As we begin this year, remember our ROAR motto because Anniston tigers are:
