Middle College Policies and Procedures

Eligibility

Students must have a 21 composite ACT score with a 20 subscore in each subject. Students must also have a 3.4 GPA at the end of their 10th-grade year.

Enrollment

Students will be enrolled in at least 15 hours per semester at MGCCC Harrison County Campus. Students may also enroll in a class at GHS. This includes extracurriculars, CTE courses, and foreign language classes.

Tuition & Fees

All tuition, fees, and books are covered by GHS during the fall and spring semesters up. If a student takes over 17 hours, they will be responsible for the additional class's tuition and books. Students who choose to take classes in the summer between their junior and senior years will pay tuition, fees, and books.

Graduation

Upon successful completion of their associate's degree, all Collegiate Academy graduates will sit together during GHS graduation. Students will be recognized for their accomplishments during the graduation ceremony

Student Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the student to check in with Mrs. Celentano as directed, typically every other week. During the check-in, students will provide grades. Each student will sign a FERPA release and designate at least one parent/guardian to receive information regarding their grades. Students will be responsible for attending required events on the GHS campus (i.e. institute seminars, junior ACT).

Transportation

A bus will depart GHS campus each morning at 7:40 to transport students that need transportation to MGCCC. Students must arrange personal transportation to high school, if needed, to ride the 7:40 bus. A bus will pick up students at 1:00 at MGCCC to return to the GHS campus.

Probation

A student will be placed on probation if they earn a GPA below a 2.5, fail a course, or are dropped from a course. A student on probation is required to log 5 hours per week in the Learning Lab as well as check-in weekly with Mrs. Celentano. If a student does not finish the following semester with a GPA higher than 2.5, fails another course, or is dropped from another course, the student will be dismissed from the program.

Immediate Dismissal

Students will be dismissed from the program immediately if they fail 2 courses, are dropped from 2 courses, or have a GPA below 1.5.
