- <u>Bell-ringer</u>: Journal Prompt #3: What are your thoughts on the following statement? Do you agree or disagree? Why?
 - Although Gregor's death represents a tragic failure to end his own alienation, the falling action suggests that the death is transformative and positive. At the story's climax, Gregor's struggle ends, concluding his tragic life. The life of his family, however, is on its way to renewal.
